YNH-CEPDR has experience in developing and delivering:

Emergency Operations Plans (EOPs) and/or Emergency Management Plans (EMPs)

- Review of an organization's strategic approach, capabilities and capacities for responding to emergencies
- Review of EOPs and EMPs for compliance with The Joint Commission, NIMS, CMS, OSHA and NFPA requirements
- Assistance with planning to be self-sustaining for at least 96 hours

Emergency Operations Plan Annexes

- Assistance in addressing topics such as evacuation, decontamination, mass casualty care and mass fatality management
- Development of special populations annexes

Business Continuity Plans

- Development of a business impact analysis and business continuity plans
- Assistance in addressing topics such as recovery team task lists, recovery resources and damage impact
- Development of mitigation implementation strategies
