- S: No change to the use of respiratory protection across YNHHS/YM
- B: The use of appropriate respiratory personal protective equipment (PPE) has and continues to be a principal action to protect oneself and others from the spread of SARS-CoV-2, the virus responsible for COVID. Recently, Connecticut state government and the federal government have made limitations to previous requirements for mask use.
  - Appropriate respiratory PPE includes face masks, surgical masks and respirators as defined in "YNHHS/YM PPE Policy for COVID-19 Prevention".
- A: The level of community transmission of COVID remains substantial to high across the YNHHS and YM service areas. Continued widespread use of face masks is necessary to sustain a safe environment for patients, family/visitors and staff.
- R: Consistent with the YNHHS/YM PPE Policy;
- 1. All patients and visitors are required to wear a face mask, or other appropriate respiratory protection, when in any healthcare facility, including all ambulatory settings.
- 2. All staff are required to wear face masks, or other appropriate respiratory protection, when in any YNHHS/YM facility. Respiratory PPE use is not required when outdoors or alone in a private office.
